Mission Statement

To educate, promote, provide, and improve HEALTHCARE!

Executive Summary: In Mary's Name is a non-profit organization that provides Mammograms to women in the Philadelphia area by partnering with health centers and Fox Chase Cancer Center Mobile Mammogram Unit. In Mary's Name supports patients during chemotherapy by donating blankets, gloves, hats, scarves, pens, and activity books to local infusion centers. The organization supplies Surviving Chemotherapy bags and Mastectomy bags when requested.

Program: "Got Breasts? Get A Mammogram!" is a program to provide access to Breast Cancer screening to inner city women who have limited access to this screening process during normal screening hours.

Patient Population: In Mary's Name "Got Breasts? Get A Mammogram!" campaign is for women ages 40 and over and those with a family history of Breast Cancer.

Goal: To provide/improve access to healthcare for early detection of Breast Cancer, educate about Breast Health, promote Breast Cancer Awareness, and decrease Breast Cancer deaths.

Evaluation Plan: Pre-event survey when patients are scheduled for the screenings to address patient's needs and concerns about getting to their appointments. Post event survey to evaluate the care provided to patients.
